Ms Sara Barragán Montes works for the Health Emergencies programme at the Headquarters of the World Health Organization in Geneva, Switzerland, as technical officer for the global border health response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

She joined WHO in 2013 initially working in the programmes of Health Equity and Social Determinants of Health, and Migration and Health in the WHO Office in Venice, Italy. In 2015-16, Sara took part of the WHO European Task Force for the response to the refugee and migrant crisis and coordinated the development of the first Resolution, Strategy and Action Plan for Refugee and Migrant Health in the European Region. In 2018, she joined the Health Emergencies programme at the WHO Regional Office for Europe in Copenhagen, Denmark.

Before joining WHO, Sara worked in the third sector and media in Spain and Mali. She has also written on health policy and forced migration for two books edited by the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine (LSHTM) and University College London (UCL).

She holds a MSc on Global Health Policy from the LSHTM; a MA on International Relations from IE University; and two Bachelor's Degrees on Journalism and Communications from the University Carlos III of Madrid.
