Jacques Demotes, MD-PhD, is a neurologist and professor of cell biology. While leading a clinical research centre (INSERM-CHU Bordeaux), he founded in 2004 the European Clinical Research Infrastructure Network (ECRIN), a European research infrastructure supporting multi-country clinical research in Europe. ECRIN is a public, non-profit, intergovernmental organization with an 'ERIC' legal status since 2013, with headquarters in Paris and national hubs in each of its 13 member countries. ECRIN federates more than 130 clinical trial units, develops tools and procedures to facilitate multinational trials, and supports investigators and sponsors during the planning and conduct of multinational clinical trials, in any disease area, through consulting and operational trial management services.
