Gloria Ghéquière (b. 1991) is adviser on European affairs and pharmaceutical policies to Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Social Affairs and Public Health Frank Vandenbroucke. She was a driving force behind the Belgian Presidency of the Council of the EU, which resulted in the establishment of the Critical Medicines Alliance.

Before entering the Belgian government, she worked on international trade at the European Parliament. She helped establish the special committee on COVID-19 (COVI), which was tasked with formulating lessons and recommendations for the European response to health crises.

Ghéquière studied Philosophy at Ghent University and European Studies at the Catholic University of Leuven. In 2023, she was nominated one of the most influential policymakers in the EU by Politico.
