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Mr Thomas Hofmann is heading the Section “Emergency Preparedness and Response” at the European Centre for Disease Prevention and Control (ECDC) in Stockholm. This Section also hosts the Secretariat for the EU Health Task Force, which supports countries in their national preparedness and response work. Moreover, he is member of the GOARN Steering Committee and involved in collaborations and projects with countries and national CDC’s around the world. In his capacity he has also been guiding the design and implementation of the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Assessments (PHEPA), which became mandatory for all EU/EEA countries in 2024.

Before he joined the Centre in 2021, he was working for WHO and the WHO Health Emergencies Programme (WHE) in various offices and functions. Besides directly supporting low- and middle-income countries with capacity building and during response operations, he was engaged in several multi-sectoral projects and process related to preparedness planning, e.g. One Health, aviation and transport, civil-military collaboration, etc.
