Petja Orre is Director of Primary Healthcare at Mehiläinen, one of the largest private health and social care providers in Northern Europe, operating in seven countries. He is an MD and a specialist in public health medicine.

From 2022 to 2025 he served as CEO of Harjun terveys, a joint venture between Mehiläinen and the Päijät-Häme wellbeing services county, responsible for public health and social care centre services for a population of 134,000. In his current role he oversees Mehiläinen's primary healthcare business, including outsourced public health centre services and public-private partnerships with Finnish wellbeing services counties.

Before joining Mehiläinen, Orre held several leadership positions in public-sector primary healthcare, giving him broad experience of both public and private service provision. He lectures regularly on healthcare leadership, digitalisation and artificial intelligence, and is involved in research on healthcare digitalisation. He has served on the board of the Finnish Medical Society Duodecim. In 2019 he was named healthcare influencer of the year by Medi uutiset, a Finnish news outlet covering the health sector.
