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Miguel Paiva holds a degree in Economics from the Faculty of Economics of the University of Porto. He completed postgraduate studies and extensive training in healthcare management and leadership. He is currently Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Local Health Unit (ULS) of São José, based in Lisbon and one of the largest healthcare organisations in the country, leading a group comprising eight public hospitals and multiple primary care units. Prior to this, he served as Chairman of the ULS Entre o Douro e Vouga, an entity within Portugal's National Health Service responsible for managing four public hospitals in the center of Portugal, as well as primary healthcare units across the municipalities of Santa Maria da Feira, Oliveira de Azeméis, Ovar, Arouca, Vale de Cambra, and S. João da Madeira. He has also held senior leadership positions in other organizations within the Ministry of Health, as well as in the private healthcare sector. He is a lecturer at the Northern School of Health of the Portuguese Red Cross.
