Jean Saslowsky is Chief Executive Officer of EURORDIS-Rare Diseases Europe, the independent voice representing people living with rare diseases across Europe. He joined EURORDIS in June 2026, bringing more than 25 years of leadership experience across the health, humanitarian and social impact sectors.

Before joining EURORDIS, Jean served as Director of Programs, Operations and Advocacy at CARE France, where he led international operations across 50 countries and advocacy engagement with French and European decision-makers. He previously served as Secretary General of the international network of Médecins du Monde (Doctors of the World), coordinating 15 national organisations across Europe, the Americas and Asia and helping to develop the network's first global strategy.

Jean has also served as Director General of Fondation La France s'engage, supporting social innovation and strengthening partnerships with companies and philanthropic organisations.

Throughout his career, Jean has worked at the intersection of health, international cooperation, advocacy and organisational development. He began his career in humanitarian field operations, including assignments in Bosnia and Georgia, experiences that shaped his long-standing commitment to public service and solidarity.
