She currently leads the Secretariat of the European Partnership on One Health AMR (EUP OHAMR), a €253 million initiative bringing together 53 partners across 30 countries and the European Commission to boost research and innovation. Previously, she led the UK Government's £145 million Global AMR Innovation Fund (GAMRIF) within the Department of Health and Social Care, supporting the development of accessible and equitable solutions for low- and middle-income countries. Her work focuses on fostering international collaboration and advancing coordinated research action against the global challenge of AMR.
