Dr. Liisa-Maria Voipio-Pulkki is currently Senior Adviser of International Affairs at the Finnish Ministry of Social Affairs and Health. She has served as the Ministry's Chief Medical Officer and Director General of Strategic Affairs in 2018-21, and was an active member of the Ministry's COVID-19 steering group in 2020-2022. She joined the Ministry in 2010 as the Director of the Health Care Group, concentrating on health system reforms, pharmaceutical policies, legislative and other health system governance issues. Since 2017 she has chaired the Steering Committee of the European Observatory on Health Systems and Policies. Since 2014 she was actively involved in the Finnish Government's "Health Growth Strategy", focusing on implementation of innovations in health systems, digitalization and secondary use of health and social data.

Previously she was employed as the Senior Medical Adviser of the Finnish Association of Local and Regional Authorities in 2004-2009, Chief of Emergency and Acute Care of the Helsinki University Hospital District in 2000-2004 and as a specialist the Turku University Hospital in Finland in 1980-90's. She received her MD degree from the University of Helsinki in 1979 and is an internal medicine and cardiology specialist.
