




Statistics at a glance


Which activities did you find most rewarding?

The respondents perceived the debates and content to be very engaging, however, technical difficulties were considered disruptive.

"When the technology worked, it was very satisfying."

While several comments pointed out that in person participation is a preferred format for many, the digital EHFG also allowed participation from a wider audience.

"Due to other commitments I was not able to participate in previous EHFG events. Digital participation was and probably will be very suitable option for me even so I value and prefer in person participation."


"It would be advisable to consider the possibility of online participation in the future for people interested in the topics dealt with in the Forum but not able to travel to Bad Hofgastein."





"Too complicated. Simple tools which work help to focus on content. And Gastein is all about content."






