I. What?

A. EU public procurement Directives apply to

- Public authorities who are contracting authorities, contracting entities or bodies governed by public law
- For the purchase of public works, supplies, services
- Contracts for pecuniary interest in writing
- Estimated value above a certain threshold set in Dir. 2014/23, 2014/24 and 2014/25

- Preliminary marktet consultation
- Call for tender or participation
- Tender specifications: subject, selection and award criteria, etc.
- Framework Agreement mini competitions



II. How does it work?

- Award criteria:
 - Price
 - Cost
 - Cost-effectiveness approach: Life cycle costing or Best price quality ratio: award criteria linked to the subjectmatter
 - Other criteria linked to the subject matter

III. Examples of smart public procurement

Public procurement procedure for the purchase of lenses for the treatment of cataract with a result focus

- → Risk of serious eye inflammation reduced by 80%
- → Direct cost reduction of 1%





IV. Measures taken by the Commission

- Several meetings at Brussels for public procurement experts in the health sector
- In October 2017 the Commission adopted a Recommendation with regard to professionalization to the Member States.




