



General medicine in Austria


- Little possibility for flexible and integrated forms of work, no structured form of collaboration





EFSI investment by sector*




Target by 2020 **EUR 500**bn

EIB's first backing for Primary Health Care investment in Europe supports 14 schemes across Ireland



14 new Primary Care Centres are to be built across Ireland following agreement of a new EUR 70 million 25-year loan from the European Investment Bank. This represents the EIB's first support for healthcare investment in Ireland and the first

dedicated backing for Primary Health Care anywhere in Europe. The new PPP-based scheme will support the shift from hospital based healthcare to community based care closer to patients.


